Chelsom adds sparkle and shine

A complete multi-million pound restoration of The Grosvenor Hotel in Victoria, London, has recently taken place with the aim of restoring the Listed building to its former glory. An elegant addition to the lobby is a magnificent crystal basket chandelier from lighting design specialist, Chelsom.

Suspended from a silk-covered chain within the vast entrance void, the chandelier has an overall drop of 8m. The fixture comprises over 300 individual strands of Egyptian crystal secured onto a slim metalwork structure finished in French Gold. Lit from within by 65 E14 LED lamps, the fitting adds sparkle and glamour to the reception area, while subtly highlighting the restored ornate plasterwork and rich marble columns with gold leaf capitals.

Built in 1862 as the first of London's great railway hotels, The Grosvenor Hotel is a striking example of Victorian architecture and opulence. Under the careful guidance of English Heritage, the restoration – along with the new interior specification by ADS Design – has ensured that the four-star hotel retains its distinctive historic character while providing the comforts and technology of the modern era.
